

## REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (CONSULTING SERVICES – FIRMS SELECTION)

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand has applied for financing in the amount of USD 428.05 million equivalent to 85 % of project's financial cost from the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) toward the cost of the U-Tapao International Airport Expansion Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for civil work and consulting service to be procured under this project. The Implementing Agency of the Project is the Royal Thai Navy, U-Tapao International Airport Second Runway and Taxiways Project Management Unit (UTPRW-PMU). The consultancy services fee for the Second Runway and Taxiway are approx. USD 12.18 million, the Bank Loan approx. USD 10.36 million (85 %) and The Government of Thailand shall provide the government budget worth approx. USD 1.83 million (15 %) excl. VAT.

The scope of the consulting services ("the Services") include construction supervision of the civil works contract and performing the role of "The Engineer" in accordance with the Conditions of FIDIC Construction Contract 2nd Ed (2017 Red Book), including all matters concerning administration and implementation of the contract including quality control, environment, social, health and safety (ESHS) aspects, work progress, and dispute resolution. The estimated key expert person-months required for the assignment is about 370 person-months. The assignment is expected to commence in September 2024. Duration of the contract will be approximately 37 months.

U-Tapao International Airport Second Runway and Taxiways Project Management Unit (UTPRW-PMU) now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- a. Consulting firm or the lead member of a Joint Venture (in the case of a Joint Venture) shall have experience of major contracts completed in the past ten (10) years in Construction supervision of Airport Construction (Only Runway, Taxiway and Apron) or Motorways or Highways or Railway or Mass rapid transit (an urban public transit system using underground or elevated trains). They shall submit all the related Contracts by ranking them according to the highest CSC contract value.
- b. Consulting firm or lead member of a Joint Venture (in the case of a Joint Venture) having average annual turnover (Revenue from Sales and Services) in the past ten (10) years.
- c. Credential of the firm or all members of a Joint Venture (in the case of a Joint Venture) including core business and years in business.
- d. Consulting firm or the lead member of a Joint Venture (in the case of a Joint Venture) having experience with Multilateral Development Banks (MDBs) or International Organizations (AIIB, ADB, World Bank, KfW, JICA, JBIC, KOICA, NEDA) in the past ten (10) years will be an advantage (The interested consulting firm or the lead member of a Joint Venture can submit other contract apart from criteria a.).

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

The Expression of Interest (EoI) should contain sufficient supporting documents to substantiate the claim of the Consultant towards their qualification as per the short-listing criteria. The EoI should not exceed the length of 35 pages. The EoI must include the followings:

- a. Introductory letter on letter head (with complete contact details – name of contact person, mailing address, telephone, fax, email etc.) explaining how the firms is best suited to deliver the task
- b. Organization profile with Organization Chart
- c. Annual reports with information on turnover (Revenue from Sales and Services) for the last 10 years
- d. Details of proposed contracts undertaken in the past 10 years.
- e. Short note on the reference contracts implemented by the Consultant Firm pertaining to the shortlisting criteria

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section II, paragraph 4.4, and paragraph 4.9 of the AIIB's "Procurement Instructions for Recipients" June 2, 2016, setting forth the AIIB's policy on conflict of interest and eligibility.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Instructions for Recipients.

The Government of Kingdom of Thailand has applied for financing from the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB or the Bank) toward the cost of the U-Tapao International Airport Expansion Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for C2.1 - Construction of Second Runway and Taxiway. This will include the construction of a 3,505-meter length by 60-meter width runway developed to accommodate all aircraft models. The runway alignment will be constructed parallel to and be located approximately 1,140 meters from the existing runway. The construction includes the relevant earthworks and site preparation, taxiway, drainage system and structure, visual aid system, airfield ground lighting system and pump station. (Hereinafter called as 'Package C2.1'). The Estimated Procurement Cost of the Construction of the Second Runway and Taxiway is THB 15,200,123,971.91 (Fifteen billion two hundred million one hundred twenty-three thousand nine hundred seventy-one baht and ninety-one satang Thai Baht), funded by AIIB's loan (85% of the procurement cost), and the Government of Kingdom of Thailand shall provided a 15% counterpart fund. The only 0% rate of value-added tax (VAT) applied to AIIB's financing.
2. U-Tapao International Airport Second Runway and Taxiways Project Management Unit (UTPRW-PMU), now invites sealed Tenders from eligible Tenderers for Construction of Second Runway and Taxiways fulfilling the qualification criteria as mentioned in the Tender Document. The completion period of work is 1,095 days. Tenderers are advised to refer the clauses on eligibility (Section 1, Clause 4) and minimum qualification criteria (Section III - Evaluation and Qualification Criteria) given in Part 1 of Tender Document, to the participation in the Tender.
3. Tendering will be conducted through International Open Competitive Tendering procedures as specified in the Bank's Procurement Instructions for Recipients (PIR), and is open to all eligible Tenderers as defined in the PIR.

4. Interested eligible Tenderers may obtain further information from the Office of U-Tapao International Airport Second Runway and Taxiways Project management UNIT, and inspect the Tender Document during office hours 08.30 a.m. to 04.30 p.m. GMT+7 at the address given below.
5. The Tender Document can be purchased by interested eligible Tenderers upon the submission of a written request to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of THB 50,000 (Fifty Thousand Thai Bath only).
